Half term holiday The half term holiday begins at 3.15pm today. We hope the children enjoy their well-deserved break.


School closed for non-pupil day Please note that we are closed for staff training on Monday 24th February. We hope you enjoy the extra day's holiday following our


2.30pm. We hope you can join us for this very special time to share our favourite tales together.
