As you may be aware, Year 4 will take part in the statutory multiplication tables check (MTC) for the first time, in June this year. The purpose of the check is to determine whether pupils can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. To help support our children in

preparing for this, Mrs Barnes has organised a competition across the six CAST primary schools in Plymouth. In the next few weeks the Year 4 children will battle on Times Table Rock Stars to discover who is 'Top of the Rocks!' Please can we ask parents to encourage daily practise of multiplication facts not just on TTRS but also through more 'traditional methods.'
