


In addition to this, we will be launching an attendance cup which will be awarded on a weekly basis to the class with the highest attendance.

Recognition of good behaviour We have been exploring further ways of recognising children who behave consistently well in class and in the playground. This is part of our drive to raise the profile of those children who behave well day in, day out; and particularly those children who display good learning behaviours in class. We are keen to acknowledge the positive contribution they make to our school. With this in mind, we are introducing weekly Golden Time after the holiday.
